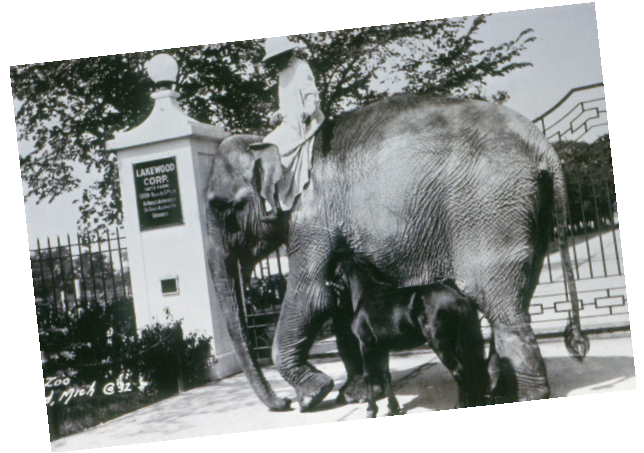


Lakewood Farm and Zoo
